

Report on programmes undertaken by Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas
'Swachh Bharat' Abhiyan till March, 2015

Under Swachh Bharat - Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyan, Oil & Gas Companies have identified over 19,000 toilets, of which, over 8900 toilets have already been allocated in consultation with State Governments and Ministry of Human Resource Development. As of 13th March, 2015, works have been awarded for construction of 7176 toilet blocks, construction works are in progress in 1331 toilet blocks and construction has been completed in 49 toilet blocks.

OMCs have provided 43399 clean toilets at their Retail Outlets and 100 new toilets have been constructed. Regular inspections are being carried out by the management and surprise visits by senior officials of the Ministry.

A number of projects have been undertaken towards Shramdaan, engaging employees of the Ministry, attached offices and PSUs. Regular activities are being taken up by Oil & Gas PSUs around their areas of operation. Oil & Gas PSUs are also conducting regular miscellaneous activities viz. cleanliness drives, awareness campaigns, walkathons, competitions, plays etc.

Under 'Waste to Fuel' programme 9 cities – Puri, Guwahati, Ujjain, Haridwar, Varanasi, Kochi, Ajmer, Pushkar and Amritsar have been adopted by Oil & gas PSUs. Modalities are being worked out for the pilot projects.
