2. The executive council will be responsible for:

- i. Guiding the implementation of the recommended action plan.
- ii. Establishing sub-committees and implementation teams to work on action areas.
- iii. Reviewing, adapting or refocusing the recommended action areas as appropriate.
- iv. Reporting on a regular basis to MoP&NG on implementation progress and submitting quarterly progress report to MoP&NG

3. Members of the Executive Council, in addition to serving on the council, may be appointed as co-chairs of the individual's sub-committees and implementation teams.

4. Implementation teams will develop and institutionalize monitoring metrics and protocols that will provide an objective record of how well the goals are achieved within the set time frame. Appropriate member(s) from the sub-committees will review these results and report to the executive council twice a year.

5. The Executive Council may invite representative of MEA, DoNER, MoEF, MoF and Industry organizations etc, whenever it required so.
