Sir,

I am directed to refer to IBP's letter No.MDPM:100/06-07, dated 25.08.2006 on the subject noted above and to say that the proposal contained therein has been considered, and it has been decided not to agree to the proposal and to reiterate that OMCs may accept all relevant documents only upto the last date of submission of application forms, as already advised in this Ministry's letter No.P-19011/3/2002-IOC (Pt.II), dated 5.4.2006.

2. In order to ensure that the applicants are able to procure relevant certificates from the competent authorities, like DGR, etc., before submission of their applications for dealerships/ distributorships or before the last date of submission of application forms, as the case may be, the OMCs may, while releasing advertisements for selection of dealers/distributors, simultaneously send a copy thereof to the authorities concerned, like DGR, Ministry of Home Affairs, etc. (depending of the Category of dealerships/distributorships), so that these authorities may be aware of the requirement of issue of the relevant certificates in time after they receive applications therefor from the prospective candidates.
