
Subject: Surrender of PDS- Kerosene quota payment of cash incentive under DBT-Kerosene Scheme- Regarding.

Madam,

I am directed to refer to Government of Rajasthan (Food & Civil supplies Department) letter No.एफ 65(2) खा.वि/ एलपीजी/ PMUY/केरो.प्रो. रा./2016 dated 8th January, 2019 on the subject cited above and to say that quota lapsed by the State Govt. (8196 KL in 2nd quarter 2018-19 and 11256 KL in 3rd quarter 2018-19) cannot be considered as voluntary surrender. However, quota surrendered in 4th quarter(2018-19) i.e. 10,000 KL has been considered and accordingly, the allocation of the PDS Kerosene to the State of Rajasthan has been revised to 20000 KL from 30000 KL for the 4th quarter of 2018-19 (January- March). The overall allocation for the 4th Quarter shall not exceed 20000 KL.

2. It is further mentioned that the entire allocation has to be uplifted within the quarter itself.
