Revision of Guidelines for Selection of Regular LPG distributorship.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Indian Oil Corporation Limited 's letter No. SL/1702 dated February 15th, 2010 on the above mentioned subject vide which a proposal for revision in Guidelines was submitted. The Industry's proposal has been approved subject to the following:—

- I. All applicants will have to satisfy the minimum laid down eligibility criteria with regard to educational qualification, availability of financial resources, ownership of land for godown/showroom etc., as contained in the industry's proposal referred to above. The proposed eligibility criteria is approved subject to the maximum age of the applicants being 45 years on the date of application.
- II. All those who fulfill these eligibility criteria will be included in the draw of lots (which will be as per the selection procedure in RGGLVY).
- III. Once the roster is prepared, locations falling under open category will be offered to the Department of Food and Civil supplies of the State Government for direct award of distributorships. The State Government may respond within 45 days from the date of receipt of communication by the State Government. This facility may be extended not only to Government department/PSU but also to government promoted cooperatives like Marketing Federation and Women Groups fulfilling eligibility criteria. If no response is received, then the location will be advertised along with other reserved category locations. Once
