Sub : **Regarding CSR Scheme for released of One time Grant to BPL /AAY
Families in Delhi for release of New LPG Connections.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. (21)/F&S/Fuel/CSR Scheme/2012/645 dated 22.06.2012 on the above mentioned subject and to say that the matter has been examined and it has been decided to convey the approval to provide Rs. 700/- from the CSR Scheme (by including 3.25 lakh customers of AAY & BPL in the CSR scheme) on the following conditions:-

- (i) The Kerosene allocation of Delhi will be progressively reduced as eligible BPL beneficiaries under the AAY scheme & BPL families list receive LPG connections in pro-rata manner and made zero not later than 31.01.2013 (as agreed by Government of Delhi itself).
- (ii) The Government of Delhi will be required to enable deduplication through door to door verification of at least 10% duplicate LPG connections in coordination with OMCs.
- (iii) Under the scheme after receiving the preliminary list from the State Government, the OMCs will finalize the list of consumers fulfilling safety norm and single connection norm. This list will have to be then vetted by Government of Delhi and certified to be BPL before the connections are release by the OMCs.
