Sir,

I am directed to refer to IOC's letter No. SL/AKM/1601 dated 09.10.2012 on the above mentioned subject and to say that the proposal has been approved with the condition that such customers may be allowed subsidized connection on completion of KYC check and De-duplication at inter and intra company level. However, they may be issued domestic LPG connection at domestic non-subsidized rate if they so desire and in this case KYC check/ deduplication will be done subsequently. This connection would be liable to be blocked and consequent legal action if the information is found wrong or he is later found to be in possession of a subsidized connection. The subsidized cylinder entitlement will commence only after KYC verification and inter-intra company de-duplication. Till such time all cylinders will have to be supplied at domestic non-subsidized rates against this connection.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
