

Scientific Advisory Committee (SAC) on Hydrocarbons

Objective:

To advise on policies relating to Science and Technology and measures to implement them to ensure optimum processing of hydrocarbon raw material for use as fuels and chemicals.

Composition of the Committee:

Chairman is nominated from Head of an Institution of Oil Industry. Members & Ex-Officio Members are nominated from Oil Industry and permanent invitees are Secretary, Joint Secretary (Refinery) and Director (Refinery) of Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas (MoP&NG). The Chairman may also invite any other person (s) to attend the meeting of the Committee or assist the Committee.

The minutes of SAC meetings are not accessible to public.

Safety Council (SC) on Oil Industry Safety

Objective:

To lay down the procedures and guidelines in the matter of design, operations and maintenance as also the creation of new assets with a view to achieving the highest safety standards in a cost effective manner.

Composition of the Committee:

Headed by Secretary of Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MoP&NG) as Chairman and includes Joint Secretaries and Advisers of MoP&NG, Chief Executives of all the Public Section Undertakings of Oil Industry, the Chief Controller of Explosives and Adviser (Fire) to the Government of India and the Director General of Factory Advice, Service and Labour Institutes as Member.
