

Progress of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan under Petroleum & Natural Gas

Status as of 31.03.2019

Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas conferred with Swachh Bharat Inter-Ministerial Award on October 2, 2017

- Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas (MoPNG) was awarded the Swachh Bharat Inter-Ministerial Award by Hon'ble Minister of State, Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation in the presence of Hon'ble Minister of State (I/C), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs and Hon'ble Minister of State, Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation, in Swachh Bharat National Award ceremony held on Gandhi Jayanti, 02nd October 2017 in Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.
- The award in the inter-Ministerial category was presented to MoPNG on the basis of the activities undertaken in the past three years. This event was organized to mark the third anniversary of the Swachh Bharat Mission, Swachh Bharat Diwas, and the conclusion of Swachhata Hi Seva fortnight.

Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas conferred with Swachh Bharat National Award for Swachhata Action Plan 2017-18 on October 2, 2018

- Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas received Swachh Bharat National Award for Swachhata Action Plan 2017-18 in Swachh Bharat National Award ceremony held on Gandhi Jayanti, 02nd October 2018.
- MoPNG has allocated a budget of Rs 335.68 crore for 2017 -18, but with the help of continuous monitoring through various meetings including apex level review meetings, MoPNG including Oil & Gas CPSEs, has achieved an expenditure figure of around Rs 402 crore, showing an achievement of around 120%.

Swachhata Action Plan (SAP) 2018-19:

- MoPNG has allocated a budget of Rs 342.50 crore for 2018 -19, but with the help of continuous monitoring through various meetings including apex level review meetings, MoPNG including Oil & Gas CPSEs, has achieved an expenditure figure of around Rs 473 crore, showing an achievement of around 138%.

Construction of Toilets

- Oil & Gas CPSEs have constructed a total of 1,11,311 toilets across length and breadth of the country.

Swachh Iconic Places (SIP):

- As part of the multi stakeholder initiative, under Swachh Bharat Mission, Oil & Gas CPSEs has identified ten places that are "Iconic" due to their heritage,

religious and/or cultural significance. The goal of the initiative is to improve the cleanliness conditions at these “Iconic” places to a distinctly higher level. SIP sites are:-

- Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam, Tirupati;
 - Kamakhya Temple, Guwahati;
 - Taj Mahal, Agra;
 - Mata Vaishno Devi, Katra, Jammu;
 - Meenakshi Temple, Madurai;
 - Golden Temple, Amritsar;
 - Gangotri, Uttarkashi
 - Yamnotri, Uttarkashi
 - Gaya
 - Kalady, Ernakulam
- The best iconic place award at Swachh Bharat Awards ceremony held on 02.10.2017 was given to Golden Temple, Amritsar and special awards to Mata Vaishno Devi Temple, J&K and Meenakshi Temple, Tamil Nadu, adopted by HPCL, IOCL and BPCL respectively.

Inter-refinery Swachhta Ranking:

- An inter refinery competition based on Swachhta Index, keeping in view various parameters linked to cleanliness was undertaken, wherein a team consisting of MoPNG official and OMCs visited different refinery complexes to arrive at inter-refinery ranking.
- Panipat Refinery of IOCL emerged as the winner; Guru Gobind Singh Refinery, Bhatinda of HREL and Mumbai Refinery of BPCL shared the second position and Paradip Refinery of IOCL stood third.
- Further, Second edition of inter-refinery competition among Oil & Gas CPSEs/JVs based on Swachhta Index was launched.

Swachhta Pakhwada Ranking

- Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas (MoPNG), its attached offices and Oil & Gas CPSEs under the administrative control of MoPNG celebrated Swachhta Pakhwada fortnight with full zeal and enthusiasm from 01st July 2018 – 15th July, 2018. A maiden initiative of Swachhta ranking of Oil & Gas CPSEs/ attached offices was undertaken, wherein, based on their performance in Swachhta Pakhwada, rankings were finalized by a Committee. ONGC emerged as the winner; IOCL stood second and HPCL came third. Additionally, our attached office PPAC has been adjudged in the highly recommended category. Further, Second edition of inter-refinery competition among Oil & Gas CPSEs/JVs based on Swachhta Index was launched.

Swachh Survekshan of 4200 Retail Outlets

- Swachh Survekshan of 4200 Retail Outlets of the three Oil Marketing Companies was conducted in association with Quality Council of India (QCI)

across 50 cities pan-India was conducted. The data was collected by trained assessors through a hand-held device, monitored on a real-time basis and went through three-layered quality check. In rankings, top city was Madurai for BPCL and Faridabad for HPCL and IOCL respectively.

Innovative Activities

- A number of innovative initiatives including inter-alia Project GreenSole involving recycling of old shoes and manufacture of 5025 pairs of new shoes for poor school children and installation of 2 units of “Ashudhinashak” (incinerators not requiring electricity or fuel) in 118 schools in Hazira, Gujarat;. Launching of solar-powered clean drinking water ATMs in Tripura, Jharkhand, Odisha and Assam having an outreach of more than 1 lakh people; collection of around 700 garbage bags under ‘Cleanathon Himalaya’s programme; distribution of jute bags in replacement of plastic bags to the consumers at ROs by OMCs; afforestation initiative whereby Seed Balls were dropped at designated dry, barren lands on the sides of Highways and river side with the help of tank truck drivers, were taken by up the Oil & Gas CPSEs.
- Some of other innovative activities undertaken by Oil & Gas CPSEs, under the administrative control of MoPNG, inter-alia include, launch of Project Saraswati to tap the ground water resources along the course of Paleo-channel of river Saraswati in Haryana to tide over severe water crisis in summer; construction of unique zero energy based vegetable cellars in Nang village near Leh for helping potato farmers by preventing rotting of farm produce due to extreme temperatures; construction of bio-toilets in Leh (J&K) and Mahanandpur (Bihar), making ODF localities such as Bharatnagar (Maharashtra), Gandhigaon (Assam) etc., cleaning Himalayas in collaboration with Indian Mountaineering Foundation and organizing competitions on Swachhta Apps.
